

Beach and Park Information

Parking permits will go on sale **Monday, May 4, 2009** at the Parks & Recreation Office. Permits will be sold from **8:30 A.M. to 4:00 P.M., Monday through Friday, throughout** the season. During the months of May and June the office will extend the office hours to 7:00 P.M. on Thursdays. To obtain a season permit, **ALL** applicants must present their car registration at the time of purchase. If you are new to Town, please bring your tax bill or lease to expedite the process.

PLEASE NOTE: To avoid lines. Mail in a copy of your registration, a copy of your latest tax bill (if your vehicle is not registered to and East Lyme/Niantic address), the applicable payment (check should be made payable to the TOWN OF EAST LYME) and a self addressed stamped envelope and we will process your request and mail your beach pass to you.

As of Saturday, May 23, 2009 (Memorial Day Weekend) all vehicles must have parking permits to enter the park through September 7, 2009 (Labor Day). Park hours are **8:00 A.M. to dusk**. Lifeguards are on duty daily at 9:00 a.m. to 5:00pm beginning June 20, 2009 through mid August. **Pets are not permitted in the Park from May 1 through September 30.**

Niantic Bay Boardwalk

The Boardwalk may be accessed via the "Hole-N-Wall" beach entrance or Cini Park entrance. Attendants will be on duty starting Memorial Day weekend to monitor activities on the Boardwalk and Amtrak Beach. As always the following rules apply:

- NO Dogs on Boardwalk** - Permitted on Amtrak Beach with a leash
- NO Kite flying on the Amtrak Beach** - High Voltage wires nearby
- NO Bicycles**
- NO Rollerblades or Skateboards**
- NO Fishing from the Boardwalk**



Pavilion Rental
